
# **Rotation Assembly Sequence**






## **Rear Drive Shaft (Two Vehicle-Based Positions)**




**Step 1 (Van)**: Orient rear driveshaft according to vehicle requirements (Fig. 1A). Using M8 X 45 MM hex head bolt and hardware within hardware kit, install hex stud onto rear driveshaft end. Torque bolts to 90 in-lbs.



Van: Longer rear (Fig. 1B).



**Step 2 (Pickup):** Orient rear driveshaft according to vehicle requirements (Fig. 2A). Using M8 X 45 MM hex head bolt and hardware within hardware kit, install hex stud onto rear driveshaft end. Torque bolts to 90 in-lbs.




**Pickup:** Shorter rear (Fig. 2B).





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
#### **Rear Drive Shaft (Two Vehicle-Based Positions) - Continued**



Step 3: Apply clear lubricant liberally to bushing (front only) as shown (Fig 3).




**Step 4**: Insert rear driveshaft into crossbar, stop bushing, and through drive arm (Fig. 4). **Note**: Please use the Stop Bushing from FEA-0024/HKT-8423 Rotation Hardware Kit.



**Step 5:** Ensure cylinder tab on driveshaft points down and drive arm holes align with holes in driveshaft (Fig. 5A & B).

Apply anti-seize to (2) M8 X 55 MM hex head bolts and install with hardware as shown. Torque all bolts to 90 in-lbs.










## **Cylinder Hardware & Connecting Bar**



**Step 6:** Align cylinder clevis and driveshaft tab holes and insert clevis pin as shown.

Insert cotton pin into clevis pin and bend the end to keep clevis held in place (Fig. 6).



Step 7: Insert connecting bar onto rear driveshaft (Fig. 7).


Apply anti-seize to (2) M8 X 50MM hex head bolts and install with hardware as shown

3.3 Torque bolts to 90 in-lbs.





#### **Front Drive Shaft**




Step 8: Apply clear lubricant liberally to bushing.

Insert front driveshaft through front crossbar and rotation drive arm aligning two holes with bushing and middle connecting bar (Fig. 8).

Apply anti-seize to (2) M8 X 50MM hex head bolts and install with hardware as shown.

Torque all bolts to 90 in-lbs.



**Step 9:** Apply anti-seize to (2) M8 X 50MM hex head bolts and install with hardware (Fig. 9).


Torque all bolts to 90 in-lbs.





# **Drive Shaft Sealing**

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Step 10: Apply silicone sealant (not provided) to connecting bar ends. Using provided sealing stickers, apply to any remaining holes on driveshaft (Fig. 10).
